STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to create a lien on manufactured staves and laths.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever labors at cutting, hauling or sawing
2 of stave or lath timber or in the manufacture of stave or
3 lath timber into staves or laths and the piling of such staves
4 or laths or at cooking for persons engaged in such labor has
5 a lien thereon for the amount due for his personal services
6 and the services performed by his team, which takes prece-
7 dence of all other claims, continues for sixty days after such
8 timber or staves and laths arrive at the place of destination
9 for sale or manufacture, and may be enforced by attachment.
