STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Houlton and Woodstock

Electric Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Houl2 ton and Woodstock Electric Railroad Company which were
3 granted by Chapter one hundred and sixty of the Private
4 and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred and three
5 and extended by Chapter two hundred and twenty-two of
6 the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred
7 and five, are hereby extended for two years from the
8 approval of this act and the persons named in said act, their
9 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers

10 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be
11 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as
12 specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
