STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-three of Chapter thirty-nine of the Revised Statutes, and Section seven of Chapter sixtyeight of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-three of Chapter thirty-nine of

- 2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out all
- 3 of the present language of said section and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following: The director of the Maine agricul-
- 5 tural experiment station shall diligently enforce the provi-
- 6 sions of Sections sixteen, seventeen, nineteen, twenty-two,
- 7 twenty-seven, thirty and thirty-two, of this chapter, and,
- 8 in his discretion, prosecute offenses against the same; so
- 9 that, as amended, said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 33. The director of the Maine agricultural exper-11 iment station shall diligently enforce the provisions of Sec-12 tions sixteen, seventeen, nineteen, twenty-two, twenty-seven, 13 thirty and thirty-two, of this chapter, and, in his discretion, 14 prosecute offenses against the same.'

Sect. 2. Section seven of Chapter sixty-eight of the Pub2 lic Laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby amended
3 by striking out all of the present language of said section
4 and inserting in the place thereof the following: 'The director
5 of the Maine agricultural experiment station shall diligently
6 enforce the provisions of this act and, in his discretion, pros7 ecute offenses against the same,'—so that, as amended, said
8 section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 7. The director of the Maine agricultural experi-10 ment station shall diligently enforce the provisions of this 11 act, and, in his discretion, prosecute offenses against the 12 same.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
