IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Atlantic Shore Line Railway to discontinue operation of its ferry across the Piscataqua River in certain instances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Atlantic Shore Line Railway is hereby

- 2 authorized to discontinue the carriage of animals, vehicles
- 3 and animals attached to vehicles upon its ferry across the
- 4 Piscataqua river during such period or periods and at such
- 5 time or times as it may elect not to engage in such carriage.
 - Sect. 2. Said corporation may close its bridge extending
- 2 from the main land to Kittery Foreside to Badger's Island
- 3 to travel by animals and vehicles and vehicles drawn by

- 4 animals at such time or times and for such period or periods 5 as it may elect.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
