IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Lily Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Lily
2 Water Company which were granted by chapter one hundred
3 and two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-
4 dred and three, and extended by chapter one hundred and
5 seventy-four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
6 hundred and five for and during the period of two years from
7 the eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and five, are
8 hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act;
9 and the persons named in said act, their associates and suc-

10 cessors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that
11 were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same
12 manner and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
