STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 58 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes relating to deposits by the State Treasurer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 58 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and 3 inserting in place thereof the following:

'The treasurer may deposit the moneys of the state in any 5 of the banking institutions or trust companies organized 6 under the laws of this state or in any national bank or banks 7 located therein. Not exceeding twenty thousand dollars shall

8 be deposited in any one such bank or institution unless fifteen 9 per cent of the sum of its capital stock and surplus exceeds 10 said amount, in which case said deposit may be increased to 11 an amount equal to said fifteen per cent. The above restric-12 tions shall not apply to deposits actually made to meet the 13 payment of the bonded debt of the state and the interest 14 accruing thereon. Deposits for this purpose may be made in 15 any bank when bonded debt as above is about to mature 16 where by terms of the contract such debt and interest are 17 made payable.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
