STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Aroostook Valley
Railroad Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The time within which the Aroostook Valley
2 Railroad Company, a corporation organized under the gen-
3 eral laws of the State and by virtue of chapter two hundred
4 and ninety-three of the special laws for nineteen hundred
5 and three, shall actually commence business under its exist-
6 ing charter is hereby extended to two years from the
7 approval hereof.

Sect. 2. The Aroostook Valley Railroad Company is
2 hereby authorized and empowered to lease all or any part of

3 its property, rights, privileges and franchises on such terms
4 as it may determine; also, to consolidate with or acquire by
5 lease, purchase or otherwise, the property, rights, privileges
6 and franchises of any water power company or of any com-
7 pany making, generating or distributing electricity.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
