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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to establish a salary for the judge of the municipal  
court of Rumford Falls.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of July nineteen  
2 hundred seven, the judge of the municipal court of Rumford  
3 Falls, shall receive an annual salary of twelve hundred dol-  
4 lars, payable quarterly, out of the county treasury, on the  
5 first days of July, October, January and April, which shall  
6 be in full payment for all his services. And in case of his  
7 death, resignation or removal from office his recorder shall  
8 act and be paid the salary until his successor is appointed and  
9 qualified, and be subject to all the provisions of this act.

Sect. 2. Said judge shall render to the county treasurer, 2 semi-annually, on the second Tuesdays of April and Octo- 3 ber, a true statement, in writing, signed and sworn to by 4 him, of all fees received, or which he is entitled to receive 5 by virtue of his said office, including fees received by his 6 recorder, for the six months ending on the last days of March 7 and September of each year, and pay the same over to said 8 treasurer; and on said second Tuesdays of April and Octo- 9 ber, he shall produce and exhibit his civil and criminal docket 10 to the court of county commissioners of said county for 11 their examination, and also the original papers on file in his 12 court, if they shall so require.

Sect. 3. It shall be the duty of the county commissioners 2 to furnish and provide at the expense of the county, all 3 blanks required for the use of said court in the transaction 4 of its civil and criminal business including proper books for 5 the record of all cases arising in said court. And said com- 6 missioners shall also provide at the expense of said county, 7 necessary office stationery and supplies for the use of the 8 judge and recorder of said court in the performance of their 9 official duties.

Sect. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect July 1st, nineteen hun- 2 dred seven.
