STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, entitled "An Act to authorize the Houlton Water Company to generate, sell, and distribute electricity."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of chapter thirty-one of the Pri-

- 2 vate and Special Laws of 1905 is hereby amended by strik-
- 3 ing out the word "thirty-five" in the fourth, sixth and
- 4 seventh lines thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the word
- 5 'forty,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Said company or corporation may lease, pur-

- 7 chase, acquire and hold real and personal estate, necessary
- 8 and convenient for the purposes aforesaid, to an amount not

9 exceeding forty thousand dollars; may sell and convey the 10 same; and may issue, negotiate and sell its bonds to an . II amount not exceeding forty thousand dollars for the pur- 12 poses stated in this act, and said bonds to the amount of 13 forty thousand dollars may be purchased and held by the 14 savings banks and trust companies of Maine.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
