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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred forty-five of the  
Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven,  
entitled "An Act to provide sewerage in the town of Houl-  
ton."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter one hundred forty-five  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-  
3 seven, as amended by chapter one hundred forty-two of the  
4 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, is  
5 hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty" in the  
6 seventh and ninth lines, and inserting in lieu thereof the  
7 word 'seventy-five,' so that said section as amended shall  
8 read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation may acquire and hold real and  
10 personal estate necessary and convenient for the purposes  
11 aforesaid, not exceeding in amount one hundred thousand  
12 dollars; may sell and convey the same; may issue certificates  
13 of stock to an amount not exceeding the amount of its  
14 capital stock actually paid in; and may issue and sell bonds  
15 to an amount not exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars,  
16 to aid in the construction, repairs and improvements of its  
17 works, and said bonds to the amount of seventy-five thou-  
18 sand dollars may be purchased and held by the savings banks  
19 of Maine.'

Sect. 2. The said corporation may mortgage or pledge  
2 a part or all of its property and franchises in this State as  
3 security for bonds issued under its charter or by authority  
4 of special acts of the Legislature.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
