STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter two hundred twenty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty, entitled "An Act to supply the people of Houlton with pure water," as amended by Chapter four hundred ninety-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine, and as amended by Chapter one hundred forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, and as amended by Chapter three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter two hundred twenty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty, as amended by chapter four hundred ninety-seven of

5 nine, and as amended by chapter one hundred forty-eight
6 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three,
7 and as amended by chapter three of the Private and Special
8 Laws of nineteen hundred five, is hereby further amended
9 by striking out the words "one hundred fifty" in the seventh
10 and eighth lines, and also in the twelfth and thirteenth lines,
11 and inserting in lieu thereof in each place the words 'two
12 hundred,' so that said section as amended shall read as
13 follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation may acquire and hold real and
15 personal estate, necessary and convenient for the purposes
16 aforesaid, and the stock in whole or in part of the Houlton
17 Sewerage Company, not exceeding in all two hundred thou-
18 sand dollars; may sell and convey the same; may issue cer-
19 tificates of stock to an amount not exceeding fifty thousand
20 dollars; and may issue and sell bonds to an amount not
21 exceeding two hundred thousand dollars, to aid in the con-
22 struction, extension, improvement and repair of its works,
23 and to pay any existing debts whether represented by bonds,
24 notes, or accounts, and for the purchase of the whole or any
25 part of the stock of the Houlton Sewerage Company; and
26 said bonds to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars
27 may be purchased and held by the savings banks of Maine.'

Sect. 2. Said corporation may mortgage a part or all of
2 its property and franchises in this State as security for bonds

3 issued under its charter, or by authority of special acts of
4 the Legislature.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
