
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

RESOLVE, providing for preventing contagious diseases among Cattle and Horses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars be appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and seven and twenty-five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight, as a special sum to be used so far as may be necessary by the state board of cattle commissioners, under the provisions of chapter nineteen of the Revised Statutes of Maine, in preventing the spreading of tuberculosis, glanders, and all other contagious diseases among cattle of and horses.
