STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter four hundred sixty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, providing for the election of a superintending school committee and superintendent of schools in the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter four hundred sixty-five
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-
3 eight is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "schools" in the fifth line thereof the words 'and truant
5 officers;' also by striking out the words "city council" in the
6 sixth line of said section and inserting in place thereof the

7 words 'superintending school committee,' so that said sec-
8 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The superintending school committee of said city
10 of Lewiston, may exercise all the powers conferred, and shall
11 discharge all the duties imposed, by law, on superintending
12 school committees and district school agents; and they may
13 also appoint a superintendent of schools and truant officers,
14 for such term and with such compensation as the superin-
15 tending school committee of said city of Lewiston may
16 determine. Such superintendent may be removed at the
17 pleasure of said committee, and any vacancy shall be filled
18 by their appointment.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
