STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Madawaska Training School.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated 2 the sum of four thousand dollars for the Madawaska Train-3 ing School for repairs upon the school building, and school 4 equipments, two thousand dollars being for the year nine-5 teen hundred and seven, and two thousand dollars for the 6 year nineteen hundred and eight, and that the same be 7 expended under the direction of the trustees.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The within sum of four thousand dollars for the Madawaska Training School is asked for the following purposes; three thousand dollars for the installing a steam heating plant for the training school building. This building is now heated by three furnaces, and they are worn out, and are wholly inadequate to heat the building with the large number of students now attending the school.

Four hundred dollars are needed to put new floors in the dormitory; two hundred dollars for repairs upon the buildings of the school; three hundred dollars for painting, and one hundred dollars for new furniture.
