IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to ratify the action of the committee appointed to build a bridge across York River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The vote of the inhabitants of the town of 2 York, passed in town meeting, October 13, 1906, appointing 3 a committee of four to act in conjunction with the select-4 men of said town in building a bridge across York River 5 as laid out and ordered by the County Commissioners of 6 the county of York, and the action of said committee, in 7 behalf of said town, in petitioning the Secretary of War 8 and the Chief of Engineers that the location and plans of 9 said bridge be approved, and that said town be authorized 10 to commence the construction thereof and maintain the 11 same as provided by law, are hereby authorized and ratified.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
