RESOLVE in favor of Bridgton Academy.

---

*Resolved,* That there be appropriated the sum of three  
2 thousand five hundred dollars for Bridgton Academy for  
3 the purpose of building a dormitory, installing heat, and  
4 for the purchase of furniture for the building. The approp-  
5 priation shall be expended under the direction of the trus-  
6 tees of the academy.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The within sum of three thousand five hundred dollars asked for Bridgton Academy is for the following purposes: two thousand dollars for building a dormitory, five hundred dollars for the installing of a heating plant, and one thousand dollars for the purchase of furniture for the building.
