### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Bridgton Academy.

Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of three

- 2 thousand five hundred dollars for Bridgton Academy for
- 3 the purpose of building a dormitory, installing heat, and
- 4 for the purchase of furniture for the building. The appro-
- 5 priation shall be expended under the direction of the trus-
- 6 tees of the academy.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The within sum of three thousand five hundred dollars asked for Bridgton Academy is for the following purposes: two thousand dollars for building a dormitory, five hundred dollars for the installing of a heating plant, and one thousand dollars for the purchase of furniture for the building.
