STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to further define State Printing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The terms "state printing" and "miscellaneous
2 printing," as used in chapter one hundred fifty-five of the
3 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five shall be deemed
4 to mean all the printing and printed supplies for which the
5 state shall be holden to pay.

Sect. 2. The governor and council may, at their discre-
2 tion, contract from time to time, on the basis of competi-
3 tive bids, for the making or delivery of the paper stock,
4 engravings, electrotypes, dies, lithograph or other plates
5 required in the execution of the state printing. No such
6 contract shall be for a longer time than two years.
