## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to further define State Printing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The terms "state printing" and "miscellaneous
- 2 printing," as used in chapter one hundred fifty-five of the
- 3 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five shall be deemed
- 4 to mean all the printing and printed supplies for which the
- 5 state shall be holden to pay.
- Sect. 2. The governor and council may, at their discre-
- 2 tion, contract from time to time, on the basis of competi-
- 3 tive bids, for the making or delivery of the paper stock,
- 4 engravings, electrotypes, dies, lithograph or other plates
- 5 required in the execution of the state printing. No such
- 6 contract shall be for a longer time than two years.
