AN ACT for the protection of gray squirrels and black squirrels, so called.

Bc it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature asembled, as follows:

There shall be a close time on gray squirrels and black

- 2 squirrels, so-called, for a period of four years from May 3 first, A. D. 1907, during which time it shall be unlawful to
- 4 hunt, chase, catch, kill or have them in possession, under a
- 5 penalty of twenty dollars and costs of prosecution for each
- 6 offense.
