IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of gray squirrels and black squirrels, so called.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

There shall be a close time on gray squirrels and black  
2 squirrels, so-called, for a period of four years from May  
3 first, A. D. 1907, during which time it shall be unlawful to  
4 hunt, chase, catch, kill or have them in possession, under a  
5 penalty of twenty dollars and costs of prosecution for each  
6 offense.
