STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, entitled "An Act regulating the sale of bonds and other obligations on the installment plan by foreign corporations."

Section 1. Section one of chapter seventy-three of the 2 public laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby amended 3 by striking out the words "incorporated or otherwise" in 4 the fifth line thereof, so that said section as amended shall 5 read as follows:

'Section I. Except as hereinafter provided, no person, 7 association or corporation shall carry on the business of 8 issuing, negotiating or selling any bonds, certificates or 9 other obligations issued or based on the partial payment or

IC installment plan within this state, unless authorized under II the laws thereof.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
