STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to make valid the organization of the Middle Intervale Telephone Company, and to legalize its acts and doings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The organization of the Middle Intervale Telephone Company under the general law, under date of November twelve, nineteen hundred and four, is hereby made valid, and its acts and doings are hereby made legal.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
