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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT relating to the Bar Harbor & Union River Power  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Bar Harbor & Union River Power Com-  
pany is hereby authorized and empowered to issue its bonds  
for the carrying out of any of its purposes to an amount not  
exceeding the sum of \$2,000,000, instead of to an amount  
not exceeding the sum of \$1,250,000, as now provided by  
law. Said bonds, including the increase in issue hereby  
authorized, may be issued from time to time on such terms  
and at such rates as said company may deem expedient, and  
said company may secure the payment of principal and inter-

10 est of such bonds by appropriate mortgages or deeds of trust  
11 on all or any part of its property, franchises, rights and privi-  
12 leges now owned or hereafter acquired.

Sect. 2. In addition to its purposes as set forth in its cer-  
2 tificate of organization approved by the attorney general of  
3 the said State of Maine, October 6th, A. D. 1902, and as  
4 extended and enlarged by chapters 10 and 371 of the private  
5 and special laws of the State of Maine for the year 1903,  
6 and by chapter 272 of the private and special laws of the  
7 State of Maine for the year 1905, the said Bar Harbor &  
8 Union River Power Company is hereby authorized and em-  
9 powered to make, generate, sell, distribute and supply elec-  
10 tricity or electrically transmitted energy or power for any  
11 or all purposes anywhere within the limits of the county of  
12 Waldo in said State of Maine; provided, however, that no  
13 electricity or electrically transmitted energy or power shall  
14 be made, generated, sold, distributed or supplied by the said  
15 Bar Harbor & Union River Power Company within the limits  
16 of any city or town in said county of Waldo in or to which  
17 another company, person or firm are making, generating,  
18 selling, distributing or supplying or are authorized to make,  
19 generate, sell, distribute or supply gas or electricity or both,  
20 unless and until said Bar Harbor & Union River Power Com-  
21 pany shall first obtain the consent of such other company,  
22 person or firm.

Sect. 3. Said Bar Harbor & Union River Power Company  
2 is further hereby authorized and empowered to make, gen-

3 erate, sell, distribute and supply electricity or electrically  
4 transmitted energy or power for any or all purposes, except-  
5 ing only heating and manufacturing purposes, anywhere  
6 within the limits of the town of Hampden in the county of  
7 Penobscot in said State of Maine, provided, however, that  
8 said Bar Harbor & Union River Power Company shall first  
9 obtain the consent of the Bangor Railway & Electric Com-  
10 pany so to make, generate, sell, distribute and supply elec-  
11 tricity or electrically transmitted energy or power in said  
12 town of Hampden.

Sect. 4. Said Bar Harbor & Union River Power Company  
2 is further authorized and empowered to purchase, hold, own  
3 and enjoy the franchises, property, rights, privileges, immu-  
4 nities, shares of stock, lands and other securities of any cor-  
5 poration, company, person or firm making, generating, sell-  
6 ing, distributing or supplying gas or electricity or both, in  
7 the counties of Hancock and Waldo, and in the town of  
8 Hampden, in the county of Penobscot, in said State of Maine,  
9 under and subject however to sections 56 to 67 inclusive of  
10 chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes of the said State of Maine,  
11 and any such corporation, company, person or firm in said  
12 counties of Hancock and Waldo and in the said town of  
13 Hampden, is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and  
14 convey to the said Bar Harbor & Union River Power Com-  
15 pany, its franchises, property, rights, privileges, shares of  
16 stock, or other securities upon such terms and conditions as

17 may be mutually agreed upon by said corporations, com-  
18 panies, persons or firms.

Sect. 5. Any company or companies making, generating,  
2 selling, distributing or supplying, or which are authorized to  
3 make, generate, sell, distribute or supply electricity or elec-  
4 trically transmitted energy or power in or to any city or  
5 town in which the Bar Harbor & Union River Power Com-  
6 pany is authorized to do business, or any company doing  
7 business in any such city or town, which uses electricity or  
8 electrically transmitted energy or power in its business, is  
9 hereby authorized and empowered to buy electricity or elec-  
10 trically transmitted energy or power from said Bar Harbor  
11 & Union River Power Company for the purpose of selling,  
12 distributing and supplying it over its own lines for any and  
13 all purposes for which it has the power to sell or supply the  
14 same, or for use in its own business.

Sect. 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage and  
2 approval.
