RESOLVE, for payment of premium on bonds of clerks in
State Treasurer's Office.

Resolved: That there is hereby appropriated the sum of
2 two hundred and ten dollars to pay the premium on surety
3 company bonds on account of clerks in the office of the state
4 treasurer for the years nineteen hundred seven and nineteen
5 hundred and eight.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It has been the custom heretofore for the clerks in the state treasurer's office to give bonds signed by individuals. It is now proposed that they shall give bond of some approved surety company. There are four clerks in the office, the chief clerk will give bond for twenty-five thousand dollars and the three other clerks fifteen thousand dollars each, a total of seventy thousand dollars.
