STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 14 of Chapter 60 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Agricultural Societies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 14 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is amended
2 by striking out the words "one cent and one-quarter" in the
3 second line of said section and substituting therefor the words
4 'two cents,' so that the section as amended will read as fol-
5 lows:

'Sect. 14. There shall be appropriated annually from the
7 state treasury, a sum of money not exceeding two cents to

8 each inhabitant of the state, which shall be divided among
9 the legally incorporated agricultural societies of the state
10 not provided for by special enactment, according to the
11 amount of premiums and gratuities actually paid in full on
12 exhibition stocks and products, and provided, that no society
13 shall receive from the state a sum greater than actually
14 raised and paid by the society for said purposes; provided
15 also, that each of the said societies shall cause the prohibitory
16 liquor law to be enforced on all grounds over which they
17 have control, and not allow gambling in any form or games
18 of chance on said grounds.'
