STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State School for Boys.

Resolved, That there be and are hereby appropriated for 2 and in behalf of the State School for Boys the following 3 sums and for the following purposes, namely: For the year 4 nineteen hundred and seven, for current expenses, twenty-5 six thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs and improvements, 6 two thousand dollars; for providing homes for boys and 7 visiting boys out on probation, two hundred fifty dollars; 8 for insurance premiums on the property of the State School 9 for Boys, two hundred fifty-two dollars; for construction of 10 a piggery, three thousand two hundred dollars; for construction of vegetable cellar, three thousand dollars; for construction of ice house, seven hundred fifty dollars; for extra-13 ordinary repairs and improvements, including the comple-

14 tion of the work on the administration building, and fur15 nishings, eleven thousand eight hundred sixty dollars. For
16 the year nineteen hundred and eight, for current expenses,
17 twenty-six thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs and im18 provements, two thousand dollars; for providing homes for
19 boys and visiting boys out on probation, two hundred fifty
20 dollars; for insurance premiums on the property of the State
21 School for Boys, one hundred dollars; for construction of a
22 stable, three thousand seven hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The purposes for which this appropriation is desired are explained in the resolve itself, except the item for extraordinary repairs and improvements, \$11,860. This item is made up as follows:
