STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Branch stream and Hersey
brook, in the town of Washington, county of Knox.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any trout at any time in Branch stream or in Hersey
3 brook, in the town of Washington, county of Knox, for a
4 period of five years.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor
3 more than thirty dollars for each offense and a further pen-
4 alty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught or killed in
5 violation of this act.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take
2 effect until the commissioners of inland fisheries and game,
3 without expense to the state, have caused notices to be posted
4 in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein described
5 setting forth in substance the provisions of this act.
