STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in the two West Richardson ponds,
the two East Richardson ponds and the two Beaver ponds, in
the county of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in the waters of the two
3 West Richardson ponds, the two East Richardson ponds
4 and the two Beaver ponds, all in the county of Oxford,
5 except in the ordinary method of casting with artificial flies
6 or fly fishing.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for one person to take, catch
2 or kill more than ten fish in one day in these ponds.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor
3 more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a
4 further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
5 killed or had in possession in violation of the provisions
6 hereof.
