STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust and other mill waste into Bear river, or any of its tributaries, lying within the towns of Newry and Grafton, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Bear river, 2 or any of its tributaries, lying within the towns of Newry 3 and Grafton, in the county of Oxford, any sawdust, shav- 4 ings, bark, or other mill waste, or place or deposit such mill 5 waste or other refuse along the banks of said river or tribu- 6 taries in such manner that the same shall fall or be washed 7 into said brook or its tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty nor more 3 than one hundred dollars and costs for each offense.
