RESOLVE in favor of the Farmington State Normal School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of forty-five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 and seven and twenty-five hundred dollars for the year nine-
4 teen hundred and eight for repairs, furniture, books, etc.
