IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Peaks Island Railroad
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Peaks
2 Island Railroad Company which were granted by chapter
3 three hundred and eighteen of the Private and Special Laws
4 of nineteen hundred and five, are hereby extended for two
5 years from the time when this act shall go into effect, and the
6 persons named in said chapter three hundred and eighteen
7 of said Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
8 five, their associates, successors and assigns, shall have all

9 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them
10 by said chapter three hundred eighteen of said Private and
11 Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, to be exercised
12 in the same manner and for the same purposes as herein
13 specified.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
