STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the hunting of foxes by dogs in Swans
Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The hunting of foxes with dogs in the town of
2 Swans Island in the county of Hancock is hereby prohibited
3 for the term of five years from the date of approval of this
4 act.

Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall be punished
6 by a fine of twenty-five dollars.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
