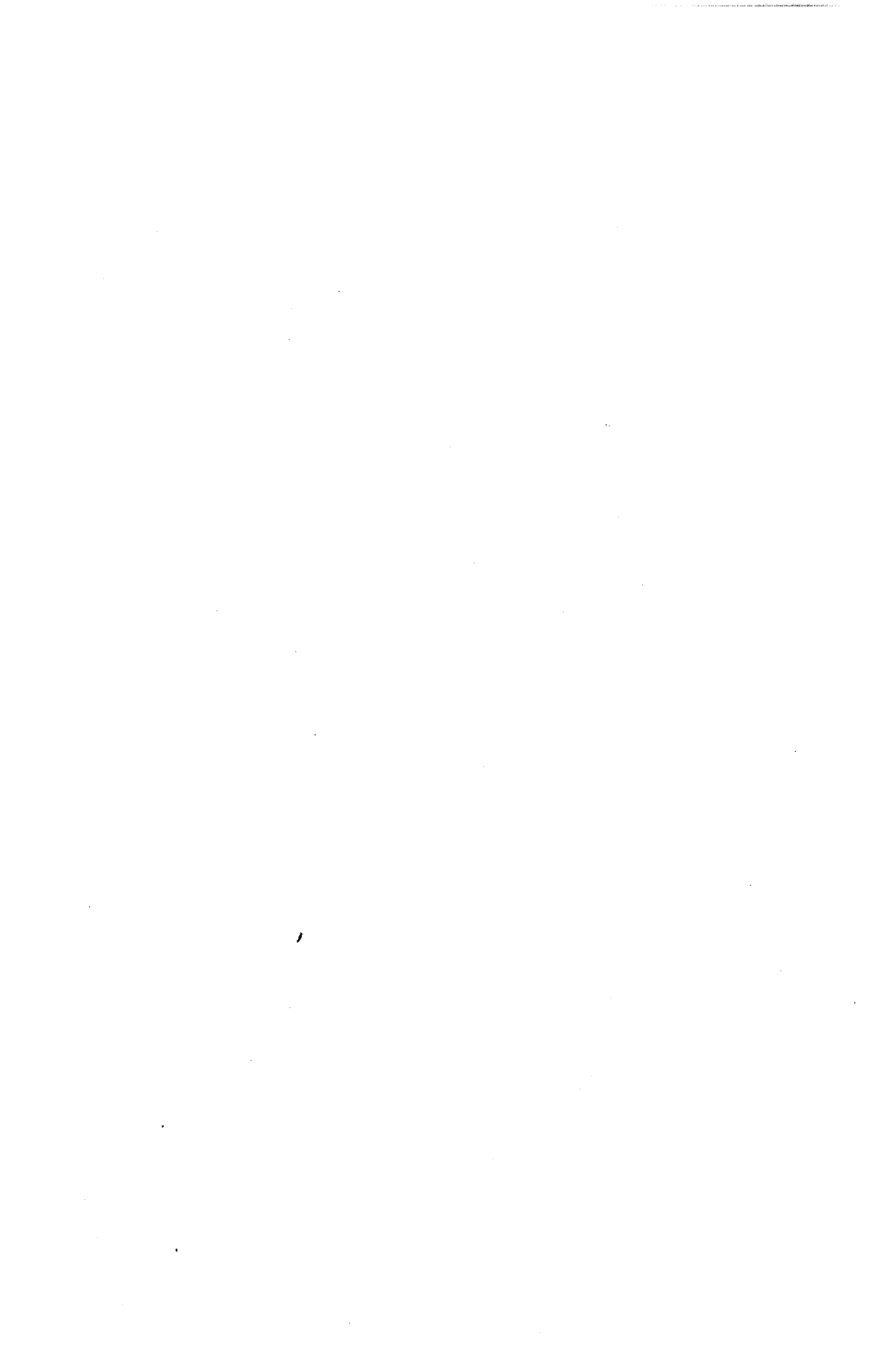
AN ACT to confer additional powers on the Duplex Roller Bushing Company, a corporation organized under the general laws of the state of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section 1. The Duplex Roller Bushing Company, in addition to, and not by way of limitation of, its corporate powers under its certificate of organization, dated the twenty-second day of February A. D. 1890, is hereby authorized to carry on the business of manufacturing, buying, selling, leasing and otherwise disposing of and dealing in machines and machinery, and parts of same ; engines, boilers, motors and mechanical appliances and devices, of all kinds and for all purposes ; also castings, forging tools and hardware, boats, vessels,

10 motors, vehicles, and all other articles, products and fabrics ;
11 also to acquire, use and dispose of patents, patent rights,
12 inventions, improvements, processes, formulas, and license,
13 contract or other rights, titles and interests, in and to the
14 same or any of them ; also to carry on, in all branches, the
15 business and employment of machinists, blacksmiths, foun-
16 drymen, mechanics, and mechanical engineers, contractors
17 and jobbers.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
