IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to empower the Benvenue Granite Company to erect and maintain wharves and docks on the shores of Crotch Island and Green Head in the town of Stonington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Benvenue Granite Company is hereby

- 2 authorized and empowered to construct and maintain wharves
- 3 and docks on the shores of Crotch Island and Green Head
- 4 in the town of Stonington in Hancock county. Said wharves
- 5 being erected or to be erected upon or adjoining land now
- 6 owned or hereafter to be acquired by said Benvenue Granite
- 7 Company.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
