STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the Bluehill Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The organization of the Bluehill Water Com-
2 pany, a corporation established by Chapter 353 of the Pri-
3 vate and Special Laws of the State of Maine for the year
4 1889 as now existing, based on assignments of rights under
5 said act from the incorporators named therein, or their
6 administrators and from the administrators of the estate of
7 George H. Stover, who was added to the number of incor-
8 porators named in said act by Chapter 499 of the Private
9 and Special Laws of the State of Maine for the year 1897,
10 to Charles H. George, and assignment from said Charles H.

11 George to Edward E. Chase, Elizabeth T. Cushman and
12 John A. Peters by which said persons were associated jointly
13 with said George as incorporators, is hereby ratified, vali-
14 dated and confirmed.

Sect. 2. In addition to the purposes named in its said
2 act of incorporation the said Bluehill Water Company is
3 hereby authorized to supply the inhabitants of the town of
4 Bluehill with pure water not only for domestic, sanitary and
5 municipal purposes, including the extinguishment of fires,
6 but also for commercial and manufacturing purposes and
7 the supplying of shipping.

Sect. 3. For the purposes of its incorporation, including
2 the purposes hereinabove specified, the said corporation may
3 take and hold by purchase, or otherwise, any lands or other
4 real estate necessary for any of the aforesaid purposes and
5 also for the protection of the water-shed of any source of
6 supply of water, which it may take or acquire under the
7 authority of its charter.

Sect. 4. Any damages for any such taking shall be deter-
2 mined and paid in the manner provided by section 3 of said
3 act of incorporation.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
