RESOLVE in favor of the town of Isle au Haut.

Resolved, That the State Land Agent be, and he is hereby
2 authorized and empowered, upon receipt of a nominal con-
3 sideration of one dollar, to make, execute and deliver a deed
4 to the inhabitants of the town of Isle au Haut, Hancock
5 county, Maine, releasing and conveying to said town all
6 right, title and interest of the state in and to all tracts of
7 land in said town denominated public landings, or landing
8 places on the plan of said town made by Lothrop Lewis.
