STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Twitchell and Round ponds in Greenwood, and to close the tributaries to Round and North ponds in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for any kind of fish 2 at any time through the ice in Twitchell pond or Round pond,
- 3 in the town of Greenwood, county of Oxford.
- Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish at any time for any
- 2 kind of fish in any of the tributaries to Round pond, which
- 3 pond is situated in the town of Greenwood, or in the tribu-
- 4 taries to North pond, which pond is situated in the town of
- 5 Woodstock, in the county of Oxford.
 - Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
- 2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the gen-
- 3 eral law of the state for illegal fishing.
