## STATE OF MAINE.

---

RESOLVE providing for the screening of Medomak pond or lake, so called, in Washington, in the county of Knox.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be  
2 and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of screening  
3 Medomak pond or lake, so called, in Washington, in the  
4 county of Knox, to be expended under the direction of the  
5 commissioners of inland fisheries and game, when the balance  
6 necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commissioners,  
7 shall have been raised by the citizens of the county of Knox  
8 and paid into the treasury of state for this purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be avail-  
10 able until the town of Washington shall have, in legal town  
11 meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town  
12 meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume

13 all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free  
14 from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not  
15 become clogged and prevent the free running of the water  
16 through the same.
