STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 57 of the Revised Statutes, relating to organization of corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one of chapter fifty-seven of the Re-
- 2 vised Statutes as amended by chapter seventy-two of the
- 3 Public Acts of nineteen hundred and five is hereby further
- 4 amended by inserting after the word "degree" in the third
- 5 line the words 'as a Masonic association consisting of mem-
- 6 bers of different orders or degrees'; also by inserting after
- 7 the word "society" in the eighth and ninth lines thereof the
- 8 words 'as an association for the promotion of good muni-

9 cipal government,' so that the said section as amended shall 10 read as follows:

'Section I. When seven or more persons desire to be 12 incorporated as proprietors of a social, military, literary, 13 scientific or county law library; as a Masonic lodge or chap-14 ter of any order or degree; as a Masonic association consist-15 ing of members of different orders or degrees; as a lodge 16 of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows; as a division of 17 the Sons of Temperance; as a tent of the Rechabites; as a 18 grange of Patrons of Husbandry; as a council of the Sov-19 ereigns of Industry; as a Grand Army post; as a relief or 20 benefit association for mutual assistance; as a monument 21 or memorial association; as a society to promote temper-22 ance; as a village improvement society; as an association 23 for the promotion of good municipal government; as a 24 yacht club, or for any literary, scientific, musical, charitable, 25 educational, social, military, agricultural, moral, religious 26 or benevolent purpose; they may apply in writing to any 27 justice of the peace in the county, who may issue his war-28 rant, directed to one of said applicants, requiring him to call 29 a meeting thereof at such time and place as the justice may 30 appoint.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
