IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 7 of chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes relating to corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in ,Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 of chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by inserting in the eleventh line of said
- 3 section after the word "directors," the words 'a president;
- 4 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 7. Their first meeting shall be called by one or more

- 6 of the signers of said articles, by giving notice thereof, stat-
- 7 ing the time, place and purposes of the meeting to each
- 8 signer, in writing, or by publishing it in some newspaper
- 9 printed in the county, at least fourteen days prior to the time 10 appointed therefor.

If all of the signers of said articles shall in writing waive notice and fix a time and place of such meeting, no notice or publication shall be necessary. At such meeting they may organize into a corporation, adopt a corporate name, define the purposes of the corporation, fix the amount of the capital stock, which shall not be less than one thousand dollars, divide it into shares, and elect not less than three directors, a president, a clerk, treasurer, and any other necessary officers, and may adopt a code of by-laws.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
