STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to Public Landings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Towns may lay out public or common landings
2 and may alter or discontinue said landings whether laid out
3 under the provisions of this act or now or hereafter estab-
4 lished by dedication or otherwise.

All procedure shall be in substance the same as is provided
6 by law in case of town ways.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
