STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section thirty of chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred twentyseven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, relating to Railroad Branch Tracks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Section thirty of chapter fifty-one of the 2 Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred and 3 twenty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and 4 five, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word 5 "pits" in the fifth line of said section as amended the words 6 'log landing or yard' so that said section as amended shall 7 read as follows:

SENATE—No. 226.

'Section 30. Any railroad corporation, under the direction 9 of the railroad commissioners, may locate, construct and 10 maintain branch railroad tracks to any railroad station of 11 another corporation or to connect with another railroad or 12 to any mills, mines, quarries, gravel pits, log landing or 13 yard, or manufacturing establishments erected in any town 14 or township, through which the main line of said railroad is 15 constructed, but not within any city without the consent of 16 the city council and for that purpose said corporation shall 17 have all the powers and rights granted and be subject to all 18 the duties imposed upon it by its charter.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
