## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifteen of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, relating to Lake Nequasset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter fifteen of the Private 2 and Special Laws of 1905, is hereby amended by striking 3 out the words: "of such kind and amount as either by itself 4 or in connection with other matter will tend to corrupt or 5 impair the purity of the water, or tend to render it injuficus to health," so that said section, as amended, shall read 7 as follows:

'Section 2. No person shall hereafter throw the body of 9 any dead animal, or other offensive material, into the waters 10 of said lake or leave the same upon the lake when frozen;

nor shall any sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter be discharged into said lake. Nothing herein shall be construed as taking away or limiting the right to harvest ice from said lake, or as prohibiting the cultivation and use of the soil in the ordinary methods of agriculture, if no excrement or foul or decaying matter is used within five hundred feet of the line of high water on the shore of said lake.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
