STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the payment of an annuity by the city of
Portland to Ann M. Burnham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The city council of the city of Portland may
2 annually hereafter appropriate and pay to Ann M. Burnham,
3 widow of Thomas W. Burnham, a former member of the
4 fire department of said city, who on the twenty-sixth day of
5 April in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred
6 and three received injuries while in the discharge of his duty
7 which resulted in his death, a sum not exceeding three hun-
8 dred dollars for the benefit of herself. Said annuity may be
9 granted to the said Ann M. Burnham during her widowhood
10 or so long as she remains a resident of said city of Portland.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
