## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of white perch in Lake Sebasticook, in the town of Newport, county of Penobscot, and in its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time on white

- 2 perch in Lake Sebasticook, in the town of Newport, county
- 3 of Penobscot, and in its tributaries, from the first day of
- 4 April to the first day of June of each year, during which
- 5 close time it shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill
- 6 any white perch.

Provided, further, that during the open season of each year 8 it shall be unlawful for one person to take, catch, kill or 9 have in possession more than eight pounds of white perch in 10 one day taken from said lake, and only for consumption in 11 his own family.

- Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill 2 in any way at any time any kind of fish in Sebasticook river, 3 so called, in said town of Newport, from the fish screen, or
- 4 Middle bridge, so called, to Lake Sebasticook.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to a penalty of ten dollars and costs for each 3 offense and a further penalty of one dollar for each fish 4 taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of the 5 provisions of this act.
