STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the encouragement of shellfish industry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of sea and shore fisheries is 2 hereby authorized and directed to expend from the moneys 3 appropriated for the year nineteen hundred seven, for the 4 protection of sea and shore fisheries, so much thereof, not 5 exceeding the sum of one thousand dollars, as may be found 6 necessary to make such experiments as in his judgment are 7 necessary to conserve, extend, encourage, develop, improve 8 and increase the shellfish industry in this State; and he is 9 authorized, during the year nineteen hundred and eight, to 0 expend from the same appropriation and for the same pur-11 poses, not exceeding the sum of one thousand dollars, if

12 in his judgment such expenditure can be judiciously made13 in the prosecution of the purposes and objects of this act.
