## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Twin Village Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter six hundred and seven 2 of the Private and Special Laws of 1893 is hereby amended 3 by inserting after the word "Newcastle" in the fourth line 4 of said section, the word "Bristol" so that said section when 5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The business to be carried on by said corpora-7 tion shall be to furnish water for the extinguishment of fires 8 and for domestic, sanitary and municipal uses to the towns 9 of Nobleboro, Newcastle, Bristol and Damariscotta, and the 10 inhabitants thereof, and to furnish electric lights for lighting

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11 streets in said towns, and to dispose of electric light and 12 power to individuals and corporations.

Sect. 2. Section six of said chapter is hereby amended by 2 inserting the word "Bristol" before the word "and" in the 3 fourth line of said section so that said section when amended 4 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. Said corporation is hereby authorized to lay 6 down pipes and to set poles and extend wires, in and through 7 the streets and ways in said towns of Nobleboro, Newcastle, 8 Bristol and Damariscotta, and to take up, replace and repair 9 all such pipes, aqueducts, poles and fixtures as may be neces-10 sary for the purposes of their incorporation under such II reasonable restrictions as may be imposed by the selectmen 12 of said towns, and all provisions of this act relating to the 13 construction, repairs, maintaining or operating works for 14 furnishing electric light or power, shall be subject to the 15 provisions of chapter three hundred and seventy-eight of the 16 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five. And said 17 corporation shall be responsible for all damages to persons 18 and property occasioned by the use of such streets and ways, 19 and shall further be liable to pay to said towns all sums 20 recovered against said towns for damages from obstruction 21 caused by said corporation, and for all expenses, including 22 reasonable counsel fees incurred in defending such suits, 23 with interest on the same.

Sect. 3. Section seven of said chapter is hereby amended 2 by inserting the word "Bristol" before the word "and" in

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3 the second line of said section, so that said section when 4 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 7. Said corporation is hereby authorized to make 6 contracts with said towns of Nobleboro, Newcastle, Bristol 7 and Damariscotta, with any village corporations that now 8 or hereafter may exist in said towns or either of them, and 9 with other corporations and individuals for the purpose of 10 supplying water or electric light or power, as contemplated by 11 this act; and said towns by their selectmen, and said village 12 corporations by their assessors, are hereby authorized to 13 enter into contracts with said company for the supply of 14 water and electric lights or power, and for such exemption 15 from public burden as said towns and such corporations 16 and said company agree upon, which, when made, shall be 17 legal and binding upon all parties thereto.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
