IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 116, chapter 84, Revised Statutes, relating to Witnesses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Section one hundred and sixteen of chapter

- 2 eighty-four of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by
- 3 striking out all of said section after the word "exceeding" in
- 4 the second line, and inserting in lieu thereof 'one hundred
- 5 dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding three months in the
- 6 county jail,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as 7 follows:

'Sect. 116. When a witness in court refuses to answer 9 such questions as the court allows to be put, he may be fined

10 not exceeding one hundred dollars, or imprisoned not 11 exceeding three months in the county jail.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
