STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section ninety-five of chapter forty-nine of
the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
twenty-one of the Public Laws of 1905, relating to notice of
injury to Casualty Insurance Companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section ninety-five of chapter forty-nine of the
2 Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 twenty-one of the Public Laws of 1905, is hereby amended,
4 so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 95. No conditions, stipulations or agreements con-
6 tained in any application for insurance in any foreign or
7 domestic casualty or accident insurance company, or con-

8 tained in any policy issued by any such company, or in any
9 way made by any such company, limiting the time within
10 which notice of the accident or injury, or death, shall be
11 given to such company, to a period of less than thirty days
12 after the happening of the accident or injury, or death,
13 shall be valid. Said notice may be given to the company
14 insuring, at any time within thirty days after the happening
15 of the accident or injury, or death, and shall be valid and
16 binding on the company.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
